Well known local artist Myrtle Tremblay was a long time supporter of the arts in Lancaster County. In her will she established a scholarship for promising students pursuing studies in the visual arts. The Lancaster County Art Association has been given the responsibility of selecting and awarding the \$1000 scholarship. This award will be given annually at the Lancaster County Art Association Annual Dinner in May.

Eligibility-

- *student must be a resident of Lancaster County
- *student must be enrolled in or accepted to a higher education art school, or college or university with a major in the visual arts which include:
 - Fine Art – Painting, Drawing, Print-making, Sculpture, Photography,
 - Commercial Art – Graphic Design, Illustration

To apply, submit the following by April 15, 2017, to the LCAA at the address above.

- *5 images of your artwork (jpeg on a CD)
- *completed application form & list of images with titles & medium
- *self addressed stamped business envelope for notification
